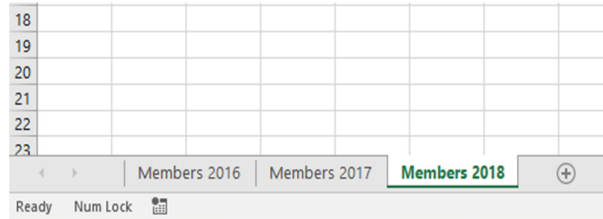

- (a) **Identify** the formula for cell G3 which can be copied to cell G4 and G5 to give the appropriate values. You may assume that the total sales value is calculated by multiplying the no. of items sold under each category from unit price and adding them together.

(For example, if 1 of each category was sold the total sales value would be Rs.180,000/-)

Note: you need to use cell references, and not cell values. Also **State** the value that would be displayed at cell G3. (06 marks)

- (b) **Identify** the formula for cell H3 to calculate the Sales Commission for Employee E1001. You may assume that sales commission is calculated at 5% of total sales value if the total sales value exceeds Rs.200,000/- and 3% of total sales if it is equal or less than Rs.200,000/-. (03 marks)

- (c) A special income tax is charged on sales commission if it is above Rs.100,000/-. If the sales commission income is above Rs.100,000/-, it is taxed at the rate of 30%.

Identify the formula for cell I3 to calculate this tax for Employee E1001. (03 marks)

- (d) **Identify** the resulting value from each of the following functions, if the cell H6 in a worksheet contains the value 12,345.67.

(i) ROUND(H6,1)

(ii) ROUND (H6,-1)

(iii) ROUNDUP(H6,0)
