Question 06

Refresh Ltd. has a supermarket chain with 40 outlets in Western Province. These outlets sell fast moving consumer goods (FMCG) as well as fresh vegetables and fruits. The company owns three acres of farmyards in the Central Province and distributes its products from there to 40 outlets in the Western Province. **Refresh Ltd.'s** supermarket outlets sell both local and foreign branded goods to ensure that their customers' needs are satisfied. Most of the payments are made through cheques by **Refresh Ltd.**

Refresh Ltd. does not operate its own transport arrangement, instead it hires vehicles to transport fresh fruits and vegetables through an online app. The management believes that this arrangement helps them to minimise the costs of transportation. However, in many instances, outlet managers have complained about the low quality of service provided by these outsourced delivery vehicles drivers. In recent years, wastage of fruits and vegetables due to poor transportation has become a huge loss to the company. Therefore, the management is now planning to purchase two trucks to deliver their fruits and vegetables.

All the cashiers at **Refresh Ltd.** are equipped with swipe machines to accept debit and credit card payments. With COVID-19 pandemic, the management has planned to invest in developing the company's own website with online payment facilities. This would enable all the outlets of the company to connect via network with each other and to use the electronic communication options in their business operations. The newly recruited IT manager is planning to incorporate all supply chain activities in the planned website through an ERP system.
